# Nomination Groups



## 1. Service Providers

This can be an organisation, team or professional who have provided support or developed their service to give support around dying, death or bereavement.



This could be

- Palliative care service providers
- Learning disability service providers
- Other health or social care providers



## 2. Advocates

A person or organisation standing up for the rights of people with learning disabilities with regards to death and bereavement support. This can be speaking up for an individual or group.



## 3. Peers

A person or group of people with learning disabilities who have made a difference to other people with learning disabilities coping with death, dying and bereavement.



## 4. Educators

This can be an organisation, team or professional who have provided teaching or training to improve support around dying, death or bereavement.



## 5. Innovation

This is for a project that has been set up to make end of life care and bereavement support better for people with learning disabilities.



## 6. Coping with Coronavirus

Who has been inspirational during Coronavirus? This may be a person, team or organisation.



## 7. Other

If your nomination does not fit any of the categories, you can ask the judges to decide for you.



The closing date is 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021.



The awards will be online on 16<sup>th</sup> September 2021.

We will send the winners a certificate and have their stories shared by PCPLD Network.

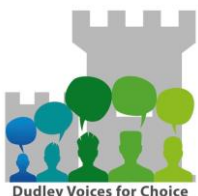
